## Hennepin County Front Door: Call 612-348-4111

- Intake for MnCHOICES assessment to obtain CADI, Developmental Disability and Elderly Waivers that help pay for supportive services.
- Get connected to treatment, case management, and services (which may include long-term housing) for people with developmental disabilities or other mental health challenges.
- Refer people to Housing Stabilization Programs in the community.
- Referrals to CMA Navigators if someone needs help searching for subsidized housing options.
- Provide Rule 25 Treatment options.
